SENATOR KELLY: Mr. President and members of the legislature, I concur completely with this problem and we have a similar problem in Grand Island, and I'm sure that other cities that are first class in Nebraska, have exactly the same problem.

SPEAKER: Now, well just a minute Senator Goodrich, because Senator Dickinson has asked to be recognized and we have several others here, stand by it's your bill and you can answer before we close things off here. Senator Dickinson did you wish to be recognized to speak on this amendment now that Senator Kelly has put in, alright he's passing, at least for now, Senator Frank Lewis are you, do you wish to be recognized on this amendment.

SENATOR FRANK LEWIS: Yes Sir.

SPEAKER: The Chair recognizes Senator Frank Lewis.

SENATOR FRANK LEWIS: Mr. President and members of the legislature, Senator Kelly, it is my understanding that with the standing committee amendments to 71, cities of the first class would be included, this is a contruent (?) jurisdiction between any governing bodies, where they have a problem with a, a county line problem. Is that correct Senator Goodrich?

SPEAKER: Now, Senator Goodrich, do you care to respond?

SENATOR GOODRICH: This is what I was going to say awhile ago, the amendment is not necessary because in the committee, we requested the committee to amend the bill and right now the bill, if you, we have adopted the committee amendments so consequently the bill now says, the governing board of any city, shall have concurrent and joint jurisdiction etc., so all cities and villages are included in it, excuse me all cities are included in it.

SPEAKER: Wait a minute, back to you Senator Kelly, you can only one of you talk at once. Senator Kelly.

SENATOR KELLY: I withdraw my amendment.

SPEAKER: Alright, Senator Kelly is asking unanimous consent to withdraw his amendment, are there any objections to Senator Kelly withdrawing that amendment? Hearing none, so ordered, the amendment is withdrawn, now Senator Dickinson we are back to you on the original bill.

SENATOR DICKINSON: Senator Goodrich, Mr. Speaker, Senator Goodrich will you yield to some questions?

SPEAKER: Senator Goodrich will you yield?

SENATOR GOODRICH: Yes.

SENATOR DICKINSON: We have been commenting alot here about a police matter, so I see, I do not see the word police or sheriff in this whole bill, I'm wondering how broad this coverage is, and neither do I see any restriction to restricting this you have referred to county from a city to another county, how about a city to the county, to the same county within which the city lies and how broad is this jurisdiction, for instance, and it does, it says in line, starting with line 7, the City Council of any city in the Metropolitan class and we can change this to first class I guess, or all cities, shall have the right and authority to exercise all powers over such street as a, have, may over-streets within it's corporate limits with or without the cooperation or concurrence of the county board or the governing body of any of them in this county.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Senator Dickinson, if you will play your committee amendment to the bill, that would read, the city
