SENATOR CARPENTER: I offer the motion that the presiding officer suggest it.

SPEAKER: Thank you. Then the motion before us is that the rules be suspended and these bills, and that the four bills be considered for introduction, all those in favor of the motion, I suppose we really need a second to Senator Carpenter's motion, Senator Marsh seconded that, all those in favor of suspending the rules in order to consider the introduction of these bills, please vote aye, all those opposed vote no. The Chair would observe that that would take 30 votes of course to suspend the rules, in order to take these four bills up at once for consideration. Senator Syas.

SENATOR SYAS: We are going to take four bills up, of course I don't know anything else, but where is there, I didn't see it, maybe I got too much junk on my desk, where is the reports of -

SPEAKER: I think they on your desk Senator.

SENATOR SYAS: They must be buried.

SPEAKER: Okay, Senator Barnett, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR BARNETT: A question of the Chair Mr. President. How are you voting on this, are you voting to the point that we would just ask for suspension of the rules once, and then vote on all four bills at once or we'll we take each one of them separately.

SPEAKER: No you're going to take each one of them separate, but we are going to suspend the rules just once, so we don't have to do it four times.

SENATOR BARNETT: Thank you.

SPEAKER: That's all you're voting on now. If we don't get 30 votes it's a matter of rhetoric anyway. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 31 ayes Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Okay, the rules are suspended and we will consider the four bills.

CLERK: Mr. President I move for the introduction of the attached bills, signed Senator Mahoney, Vice-Chairman of the Executive Board. This is a bill that is indicated on the statement of intent, on your desk as request number 757, it is a bill for enactment sections 51-112, 402, 111, 4101 and 02 relating to the legislature to change provisions relating (read).

SPEAKER: Is Senator Mahoney in the Chamber? Who has the next - Senator Carpenter do you want to handle this bill, it's request number 757, Senator Mahoney doesn't seem to be in the Chamber?

SENATOR CARPENTER: What is it?

CLERK: It's the bill to change the provisions relating to officers and employers of the legislature, to provide powers and duties of the executive board.

SENATOR CARPENTER: This is a bill to bring up to date and make corrections in the executive council, so we can do the things that was some questions what we can do now. It is suggested by the Executive Council so I presume that it ought to have consideration of a hearing.

SPEAKER: Senator Mahoney we are taking up request number 757, here on that particular bill. The rules have been suspended.
