SPEAKER: Is there further discussion? If not, those in favor of introducing this bill, vote aye. Those opposed, vote nay. Senator Whitney voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Whitney voting aye. Introducing a bill.

SPEAKER: Have you all voted? The clerk will record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, Mr. President, on the motion to introduce.

SPEAKER: The bill has been introduced.

CLERK: Mr. President, we have pending another motion. I move for the introduction of the attached bill, signed Senator Stull. This is request 558. The bill is introduced by the Executive Board. It is signed by Senator Mahoney, Vice-chairman, Senator Stull, Carpenter, Goodrich, and Savage. Read.

SPEAKER: The chair recognizes Senator Mahoney.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Mr. President, this is a bill that comes to us by way of the Interim Study Committee on Higher Education and because of the various aspects of this bill, it took quite a time to put it together in the bill drafter's offices and so now that it has come out yesterday, it's belated. The Executive Board has placed it before the Legislature and asked that it be assigned to...that it be assigned to the Education Committee for the study of the work that the Committee has been doing this past summer and we ask that this bill be introduced.

SPEAKER: Is there further discussion? A question has been called for. Those in favor of introducing this bill, vote aye. Those opposed, vote nay. Senator Whitney voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Whitney voting aye.

SPEAKER: Have you all voted? The clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 31 ayes, Mr. President, on the motion to introduce.

SPEAKER: The bill has been introduced. The chair wishes to make an announcement. There are 20 Junior High students from the Mickles School of Lincoln in the south balcony. The teachers are Mrs. Stapleton, Miss Kraft, Miss Shook, and Mr. McCabe. Will the Legislature appropriately recognize them. Mr. Clerk, are there any additional bills for introduction.

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President. I move for the introduction of the attached bill, signed Senator Schmit. This is request #79. It is a bill signed by Senator Schmit, Rasmussen, and Maresh. Read.

SPEAKER: Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, I move the introduction of the bill. This bill was brought before the Executive Board and the Executive Board referred it to the Committee on Agriculture. The Committee on Agriculture met this morning and voted all..five to nothing to introduce the bill. There is a statement of intent on your desk. It provides for a continuation of the program on grain alcohol which was started in the 1971 session of the Legislature and continued in the '72 session. It provides for an administrator, it provides for appropriation and it provides for statement of purpose and intent and I would again request the bill be introduced.
