I'd move for the adoption of these amendments, I mean, I'm asking unanimous consent but I'm expecting an objection.

SPEAKER: Senator Barnett has asked for unanimous consent to adopt the amendments which he has proposed. Are there any objections? The Chair sees no objections so unanimous consent motion is approved.
