SPEAKER: I will try to remember that, Senator Simpson. Of course, on a point...a point of personal privilege, sometimes a statement gets out before he has a chance to react.

SENATOR SIMPSON: The only thing I would say that the chair has the option of asking what the privilege is and then denying the privilege if it is not proper.

SPEAKER: Yes, if the chair can find out beforehand. Senator Snyder.

SENATOR SNYDER: A point of personal privilege, Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Now, what's your...well, we've let the other two talk. State your point.

SENATOR SNYDER: Just that my morning line was 3 to 1 today that we wouldn't be on General File. That holds for tomorrow.

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review--read.

SPEAKER: I think that completes our business except for the signing of a few bills which we have to do while we are in session. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I am about to sign and do sign the following numbered bills, LB 24, LB 107, LB 133, LB 188, LB 191, LB 192. No. Is there anything further on the clerk's desk?
