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problem is and what he is trying to do, I have no objection personally.

SPEAKER: Senator Keyes.

SENATOR KEYES: Yes Mr. President, I'd like to ask Senator Waldron a question on this? Senator Waldron, the educational service units, and I don't think it's the right thing for them to be doing, but are in the process of buying and then, buying in large quantities and then selling to school districts in the other, at bargain prices I should call it, will this in any way effect this?

SENATOR WALDRON: Senator this is a practice that I'm attempting to call to a halt here, I don't think the school districts are getting the bargain prices that the educational service unit claim their getting, and I don't think the education service units were set up to be a buyer and a seller, they were set up to perform services to the other school districts, and were not set up to get into business of buying and merchandising equipment.

SENATOR KEYES: Well ladies and gentlemen or fellow Senators, if we do take this privilege away from the educational service unit, you're going to find that one of the things that I think ought to be done is going to be done by an amendment to a bill that is not pertaining to the education service units in general. So I would have to oppose Senator Waldron's amendment, although one hundred percent in accordance with what he is trying to do but I do not think this is the place to try to do it. Educational Service Units sometimes, somebody in this legislature is going to sit down a policy of what they are supposed to do, and lay down guide lines for them and keep them out of every business in the state and every facet of education. They were sold to this state on a certain performance that they were to perform, and they are not sticking to that, but they are entering into every field. I certainly am in accordance with what Senator Waldron is trying to do, but I don't think this is the place to do it.
