SPEAKER: It has been moved that the amendments to LB 76 be adopted, is there any discussion. If not all those in favor say aye, those opposed no, the amendments are adopted. What will you do with the bill Senator?

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President I move that LB 76 as amended be advanced to E&R for engrossing.

SPEAKER: The motion has been made that LB 76 as amended be advanced to E&R for engrossment. Is there any discussion? All those in favor say aye, those opposed no. The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President we have a motion to return LB 166 to select file for a specific amendment. This bill is on final reading and bracketed, for tomorrow. Motion (read).

SPEAKER: Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I've been advised that the Banking Department makes this recommendation in order to clarify the language, it had no importance beyond that, so I move that it be reported back to select file for this specific amendment.

SPEAKER: Senator this is LB 166?

SENATOR CARPENTER: Yes.

SPEAKER: The motion has been made that LB 166 be replaced on select file, is that the motion Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes.

SPEAKER: For a specific amendment. Is there any discussion on this. Senator Carpenter has explained it. All those in favor of the motion please vote aye, those opposed vote no. This requires 25 votes. This is a motion to move a bill back from final reading to select file for a specific amendment. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes Mr. President on the motion to return.

SPEAKER: The bill is returned.

CLERK: Now Mr. President the motion is to adopt the amendments to LB 166.

SPEAKER: Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move the motion be adopted.

SPEAKER: The motion has been made to adopt the amendments. Now, Senator Carpenter I believe explained the amendments, is there any further discussion? If not are you ready to vote. This requires 25 votes. All those in favor of adopting the amendments vote aye, those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, no nays, 24 not voting Mr. President on the motion to advance, on the amendment to adopt.

SPEAKER: Well that was the motion to adopt, the amendments. The motion carries. Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move that the bill be advanced as amended to E&R for engrossing.
