Have you all voted?

SENATOR KENNEDY: We will have to have a Call of the House, I guess.

SPEAKER: Senator Kennedy.

SENATOR KENNEDY: I would ask for a Call of the House. I think we have the votes if we can just get them back on to their seats.

SPEAKER: The clerk will record.

CLERK: Senator Marvel voting aye. Senator Luedtke voting aye.

SPEAKER: Senator Mahoney...that's far enough. I can see. Senator Fowler voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Fowler voting aye. I've got him.

CLERK: Senator Carpenter voting aye.

SPEAKER: Senator Kennedy.

SENATOR KENNEDY: I would ask that the Call be raised.

SPEAKER: Senator Duis voting aye. Senator Strogger voting aye.

SENATOR KENNEDY: I also would ask if everybody just hold a minute, we will get the other one out of the way.
