

Senator Keyes.

SENATOR KEYES: Mr. President, I'd like to have Senator Marsh, Mrs. Marsh, explain Section 3 to me. I'd like to have her read it on the floor of the Legislature and explain what she is trying to do by that.

SENATOR MARSH: (Read Section 3)

SPEAKER: Senator Maresh.

SENATOR MARESH: On accommodations that are open to the public, it will not be possible to discriminate by sex, on certain accommodations that are open to the public, then?

SENATOR MARSH: Yes, sir. With the exception of, that are written into this and there are exceptions written into the bill. In other words, we're not going to allow the men to go into the YWCA's and we're not going to allow the women except where they're provided for in the YMCA's.

SPEAKER: Senator Nore.

SENATOR NORE: Mr. President, I'd like to ask a question of-- how, how do you do that, is it Ms or Miss or Mrs, or however you designate, Senator, Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: Yes, Mr. Nore.

SENATOR NORE: Well, what if some religious organization--

SENATOR MARSH: Religious organizations are exempted under this bill.

SENATOR NORE: They are?

SENATOR MARSH: Yes, Senator Nore.

SENATOR NORE: O.K.

SPEAKER: Is there further discussion? If not are you ready for the question? Question is, shall L.B. 112 advance to E&R for review as amended. Now, Senator Marsh do you wish to close? Sorry about that. All those in favor of advancing the bill as amended vote aye. Those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 11 nays, remainder not voting.

SPEAKER: The bill is advanced. The Chair would like to announce that in the South Balcony, there are 21 senior students and 4 sponsors from Prague Public School No. 104. That school is in Senator Schmit's district. We're very glad to have you visiting the Legislature this morning and we are, hope you are picking up some kind of information valuable or invaluable. The next bill is L.B. 13A. That is Senator Schmit's bill. Are there any amendments, Mr. Clerk? Read the title.

CLERK: Legislative Bill 13A introduced by Senator Schmit of the 23rd district. (read). There are no committee amendments.

SPEAKER: Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President and Members of the Legislature. These bills were, are companion bills for those drug bills that I have introduced. They have been drafted by the Fiscal Office and I did meet with some people in regard to different procedure to fund these bills. I did not find any other acceptable procedure. I visited with a member of the Crime Commission about the possibility of Federal funds, been told there will be a few funds available but nothing substantial so I think that we need
