CLERK: Legislative Bill 301. Introduced by Senator Otho Kime of the 43rd district. (bill read). There are no committee amendments. Senator Kime has an amendment to add the emergency clause.

SPEAKER: Chair recognizes Senator Kime.

SENATOR KIME: Mr. President and Members of this body. I move that this be passed on and advanced to E&R for initial. There will be some amendments. Let's see, I would like to have your unanimous consent to accept this amendment.

SPEAKER: Any further discussion of the amendment. Senator Luedtke, do you rise to speak on the amendment? Is there a need for, I am not sure the Chair heard the amendment. Is the amendment extensive? Thank you.

SENATOR KIME: Didn't you get the amendment, Vince?

CLERK: Yes, to add the emergency clause.

SENATOR KIME: Yes, the emergency clause.

SPEAKER: Thank you. Senator Kime is asking unanimous consent to add the emergency clause to L.B. 301. Are there objections? Any objections? Hearing none, it is so ordered, the emergency clause is added. Senator Kime, I'm sorry, I lost track of what was going on there momentarily. Go ahead, sir.

SENATOR KIME: Mr. President, this is just a simple bill. It's a housekeeping bill on the present law that we have. On page 3 it changes title of proof to evidence of ownership. On line 8, 1 to 17, it changes satisfactory evidence is explained. Page 9, the word "provided" is added. These are the only changes. I move this be advanced.

SPEAKER: Any further discussion of the bill? Chair recognizes Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Just a friendly question if I might, Senator Kime.

SPEAKER: Senator Kime, will you yield to a question?

SENATOR DUIS: Will this help us with the clearance of this. I did have a little difficulty last time, uh, last year with the necessity of going into too much detail for ownership. This does help this a little bit?

SENATOR KIME: This clarifies the language of ownership, yes.

SENATOR DUIS: Thank you. We were having trouble--clarification--and I thank you very much for introducing the bill and I certainly will support it.

SENATOR KIME: Thank you.

SPEAKER: Any further discussion of the bill? Question is shall L.B. 301 be advanced as amended with the emergency clause from general file to E&R initial. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Once again the Chair would inquire if you have all voted? Have you all voted? Clerk will record.
