

SPEAKER: This, this is to L.B. 278?

SENATOR STULL: Yes.

SPEAKER: Senator Stull is asking unanimous consent to have his amendment to L.B. 378 printed in the Journal. Are there objections? Hearing none, it is so ordered, it will be printed, Senator Stull. Now, do we have any other business on the desk?
