SPEAKER: Of the amendment.

SPEAKER: Very good. Any further discussion of his motion? Question now is shall L.B. 12 be returned to select file for a specific amendment as explained by Senator Chambers? All those in favor of that motion, vote aye. All those opposed vote no.
