SPEAKER: Senator Syas the Chair would recognize you but he was closing on his motion to indefinitely postpone, the debate is ceased. No, we're trying to hold down the questions because that just delays the vote on these things. We've, trying to squeeze it down here. The question is shall LB 194 be indefinitely postponed, all those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. This is the motion to indefinitely postpone LB 194, all those in favor of indefinitely postponing vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Alright now, the motion is to indefinitely postpone LB 194. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 5 ayes, 23 nays, remainder not voting.

SPEAKER: The motion is lost. We are now back to LB 194, Senator Syas what is your pleasure?

SENATOR SYAS: To advance and if someone wants to make a motion to hold, now do it now.

SPEAKER: Is there any further discussion of the bill, LB 194, the question is shall LB 194 be advanced from general file to E&R initial, all those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. We are voting on the advancement of LB 194 from general file to E&R initial. There was no motion to bracket. The motion is to advance the bill. The Chair would again ask if you have all voted? Alright, the Clerk will record.

SENATOR SYAS: I suppose I have to ask for a call of the house.

SPEAKER: Well you do if you want 25 votes to advance it. Oops wait a minute. Don't announce the vote on it, hold on, are you asking for a call of the house?

SENATOR SYAS: Yeah, sure, 22 votes, we might as well find out if we are going to advance it or not.

SPEAKER: Alright, Senator Syas asks for a call of the house, the Clerk has cleared the board, at the next bell please vote if you want a call of the house, all those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. You are voting on a motion for a call of the house, Senator Clark push your button, I'm sorry just a minute, this is a motion whether you want a call of the house or not. Thank you the Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 2 nays.

SPEAKER: We are under call of the house. At the next bell please indicate your presence and you will take your seats. Senator Clark is voting aye on the original motion. Senator Chambers voting aye on the original motion.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting aye, Senator Chambers voting aye.

SPEAKER: Gentlemen I must remind you that we are under call of the house, please take your seats. Just a minute, okay now, Senator Moylan, Senator Moylan was voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Moylan voting aye.

SENATOR SYAS: That's 25 isn't it?

SPEAKER: Yeah, but hold on just a minute, we have some hands up and we want to make sure we got them all here. Read which ones you have, the Assistant Clerk read.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Senator Chambers voting aye, Senator Clark voting aye, Senator Moylan voting aye, Senator Anderson voting aye-
