

SENATOR PROUD: I certainly do.

SPEAKER: All right. All right, is there any other. All right, seeing none other, I am going to rule then that the matter is withdrawn because there is no objection to the unanimous consent to withdraw the motion and it is therefore withdrawn.

SENATOR BARNETT: What--what's the situation? I had three or four motions up there this morning--never got to close on one. Now, where do we stand?

SENATOR BARNETT: Is it at the bottom of general file?

CLERK: Mr. President, notice of committee hearings(read)

SPEAKER: Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: I would like to ask unanimous consent; that the amendments that have been adopted by the committee and are part of 452, be printed in the Journal. That's the first motion, then I have another one.

SPEAKER: Those will be printed.

SENATOR MARVEL: Automatically? I want to be certain that they're in the Journal because the next motion is, I would like to because of the seriousness of this bill, make this the first order of business on general file Wednesday which will be the 14th.

SPEAKER: Now they will be printed in the Journal.

SENATOR MARVEL: Well, separate from the--

SPEAKER: Separate from--

SENATOR MARVEL: --printed in bill form because they're so long.

SPEAKER: But separate from the Journal, but they will be printed.

SENATOR MARVEL: O.K. They would be then available by tomorrow, then, is that right?

SPEAKER: Yes, that's--

SENATOR MARVEL: All right. Then secondly, I ask unanimous consent that the bill be the first order of business on general file on Wednesday, March 14th.

SPEAKER: All right. Unanimous consent has been requested for-- let's see, what's the, what's the number? 45--all right. Unanimous consent has been asked for the head of general file on Wednesday. Is there any objection? All right, so ordered.

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee in Revenue (read). Mr. President, we have a series of new bills; (read). That's all, Mr. President.
