

Senator Whitney. Stand by. We have Senator Barnett's motion that he's asking to withdraw. Are there objections to his withdrawal of that motion? Senator Duis, do you object to Senator Barnett's withdrawal of his motion to indefinitely postpone? Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, I, I would like to clarify if I might, I think your proper procedure here might be to ask for a motion to return it back to general file so that an amendment can be argued. We are in a unanimous consent deal and, of course, that part, I think is perfectly fine, but I think to begin with that Senator Barnett, his second motion should have been to bring it back to general file for an amendment. Now, Senator Whitney has his unanimous consent motion there; if it fails then, of course, I think a different motion would be in order and I thank you.

SPEAKER: Thank you, Senator Duis. Are there any objections to Senator Barnett's withdrawal of his motion to indefinitely postpone? I have to clear that first. No objections? Hearing none, it is so ordered, that motion is withdrawn. Now, we have another motion on the desk--on the bill. Senator Whitney's motion, I believe. Will the Clerk read the motion please.

CLERK: Motion read.

SPEAKER: Very good. There is objection, to that motion. Are there any other motions on this bill on the desk?

CLERK: None.

SPEAKER: All right. Now, Senator Barnett for what purposes do you rise?

SENATOR BARNETT: Mr. President, is this the proper time now to move this back to E&R for specific amendment?

SPEAKER: No. The bill has to be advanced now, then after it's advanced to E&R for Engrossment--

SENATOR BARNETT: O.K. I'm going to stand right here so I don't lose my place.

SPEAKER: Very good. Now, Senator Cavanaugh, we can move the bill on.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move that L.B. 194 as amended be advanced to E&R for Engrossment.

SPEAKER: Motion now is to advance L.B. 194 as amended. All those in favor of advancing the bill, please say aye. Those opposed say no. It is so ordered, L.B. 194 is advanced. On to 146 now.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E&R amendments to L.B. 146.

SPEAKER: Motion is to adopt the E&R amendments to L.B. 146. All those in favor of the motion, please say aye. Those opposed say no. It is so ordered, the amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move L.B. 146 as amended be advanced to E&R for Engrossment.

SPEAKER: Motion now is to advance L.B. 146 as amended. All those in favor of advancing the bill, please say aye. Those opposed say no. It is so ordered, the bill as amended is advanced. Now--all right. Chair recognizes Senator Barnett. We can now--

SENATOR BARNETT: Mr. President--
