SPEAKER: The Chair recognizes Senator Fellman on his motion to withdraw LB 456.

SENATOR FELLMAN: There is a dispute Mr. President between the lawyers. This is a technical motion involving the effect of deposition, and I merely would ask unanimous consent to have it withdrawn. There is a disagreement as to the meaning of it.

SPEAKER: Were there other signers on the bill with you Senator Fellman? Are there any objections to Senator Fellman's withdrawal of LB 456, any objections? Hearing none, so ordered. The bill is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President I move that LB 14 be passed notwithstanding the objections of the Governor, signed Senator Schmit.

SPEAKER: The Chair recognizes Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, members of the legislature, as introducer of LB 14, and 14A, the bill, I'd like to stand here today and ask that these bills be passed into law notwithstanding the action of the Governor.
