ASSISTANT CLERK: (reading cont'd)

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with the question is shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached. All those in favor vote Aye, those opposed vote No. Have you all voted? Once again have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: Voting.....

CARPENTER: Is this bill the emergency clause?

PRESIDENT: Yes sir.

CARPENTER: I ask for a call of the house. It is not my bill, but it serves my purpose and I have an interest in it and I think you ought to have the emergency clause.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter is asking for a call of the house. Clerk will clear the board.

CARPENTER: I don't know what Senator Warner's interest is but as usual we aren't in agreement on anything. In this case, I am.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter has asked for a call of the house. At the next bell please indicate whether you support a call of the house or not. All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. You are voting on a call of the house. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 33 Ayes, 5 Nays, the remainder not voting.

PRESIDENT: We are under a call of the house, the next bell please indicate your presence. We are asking you to declare your presence here. Senator DeCamp.

DE CAMP: Changing from no to yes.

PRESIDENT: Senator DeCamp changing from No to Yes. Senator Cavanaugh. Senator Cavanaugh voting Aye. Senator Proud voting Aye, have you all indicated? OK. I know that there is a motion to raise the call but we haven't even had time to verify who is here and who is not here yet, so the Chair isn't going to move on that motion here for a moment. I would advise you that we are still under a call of the house. We are voting on the final passage of LB453 with the emergency clause. Motion is to raise the call. All those in favor vote Aye, those opposed vote No. Your voting on the motion to raise the call of the house. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 39 Ayes, 0 Nays to raise the call.

PRESIDENT: The call is raised. Read the tally from the original motion.

CLERK: 31 Ayes, 13 Nays and 5 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Bill fails to receive the necessary majority to pass it with the emergency clause. Question is shall the bill now pass....pardon me?

CLERK: Voting Aye, Senators Anderson, Barnett, Burbach, Carpenter, Carsten, Carstens, Cavanaugh, DeCamp, Duis, Fellman,
