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to do was to take this out of the political arm of the Governor and put it under a service organization which originally it was intended to be in 1965. It should be a service organization and it is a mechanical thing a that they provide services for the state of Nebraska. That is all that it should do. They should have charge of all of the fiscal responsibilities after we allocate the money. They haven't been doing that in the way that we want to do, so the bill particularly right now would say that they must have inventories and that they must have physical inventories, building inventories, land inventories, and there is no one that you can go to in the state of Nebraska today to find out what we own even. You can't operate a business that way. For that reason we will answer any questions that you might have on the bill. There are some technical amendments a that will be offered on Select file but they are strictly technical amendments.

PRESIDENT: Thanks Senator Clark. Senator Mahoney before you speak, are you going to talk on the amendments to the bill, because we think that it be desirous to adopt the amendments and then talk about the bill. But whatever you choose. I'm just suggesting we could move it along.

SENATOR MAHONEY. Mr. President the bill is so highly important as Senator Marvel says it is, I think that we had better speak about the amendments before we pass the amendments. Senator Clark or Senator Marvel, probably Senator Marvel, would you answer this question for me?

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel, will you yield to a question?

SENATOR MAHONEY: Page 7 on your amendment, section 4. Are you ready Senator Marvel. There is hereby created the Governmental Service Commission which will consist of 5 members. The members shall include the Governor, who shall be chairman, the Attorney General, the Auditor of Public Accounts, the State Treasurer, and the Secretary of State. I can see in these amendments that you are getting so far political afieled that you are right back into the area of politics. I don't care if the Governor is Democratic or say the next Governor that comes in is Republican, then you start electing Democrats to these other offices and it is the very same thing Senator Marvel and I would ask you to give me the answer to it that we had at a state parole board who asked to get out of this field. I think that this commission certainly needs to be looked at by the members of this legislature before you enter back into a general services commission and appointed commission is something that would be more desired rather than have elected officials in this capacity. What we are trying to say Senator Marvel, what I am trying to say is that I think that we should be taking ourselves out of the political arena and put some people who could hire a controller people who would be recognized in the area across Nebraska's as Certified Public Accountants and people who know the prerequisite of a good comptroller what would you have to say on that?

SENATOR MARVEL: First of all I think that the, if you take the commission as I understand this together with the term you will find that once this is set up and once this original makes the appointment of the Director that the susceeding terms of the director do not run concurrently with the election of any of these offices. Therefore, I think that this is done deliberately so that there is no dove tailing between the offices.
