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have forgotten at times. That is that you have got to have users involved. Those that are really close to this operation.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Let me ask you then another part of that question. Would it not be better if possibly that we put the department of administrative services under the Governor and we tried it that way from some six years ago that possibly we could take this comptroller and put it directly under this legislature, and have it in that area.

SENATOR MARVEL: I think that Senator Syas would be one of the first to get up on the floor and a...a..on this and I think what this department does and George maybe you can help me here because you are our constitutional lawyer in this body Senator Syas, I think that Senator Mahoney the problem involved is this and this is one of the reasons that we very carefully try to select a commission made up of Executive Officers.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Alright I will withdraw that question Senator Marvel because of the constitutional implications.....

SENATOR MARVEL: I say...and that is the reason that we went to the Attorney General to talk about this commission in the first place.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Would you object if this commission was composed of laymen, expertise in the field of accounting and all of the other areas. Senator Nore let me finish will you please, you will have your opportunity. Would you be able to try it where the Governor could make the appointments to the commission?

SENATOR MARVEL: No sir, I would object to this because I think then Senator Mahoney we are right back where we have been now, and I'm not trying to pass reflections as you indicate on any particular executive because there have been four appointee's involved in the administration of this department, two under democratic administration and 2 under republican administrations. I think that this goes back to what I said originally, I think that your point is well taken that we should do and a...a..as many successful agencies of government have done. I will give you an example that may not be completely comparable but it does bring up a point and that is that we have voc-teck schools that are highly successful because they have advisors from many technical areas that come and help the school to determine how it can be of better service. I can see no reason why we couldn't do the same thing as far as this department is concerned.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Alright Senator Marvel, what party does the Attorney General of the State of Nebraska belong to?

SENATOR MARVEL: The Attorney General, the Secretary of State and the State Auditor, and the State Treasurer at the moment represent the Republic...represent they belong to the Republican Party and the Governor belongs to the Democratic Party but as you indicated to start with, this is entirely possible that Nebraska is now a two party state and this may change.

SENATOR MAHONEY: I really didn't have that much hope Senator Marvel as you do. I would say Senator Marvel that you, right
