add the Emergency Clause to it also by the way, if that doesn't meet with Senator Rasmussens objection. He said its all right.

SPEAKER: Please send up your motion on the Emergency Clause. A Senator Cavanaugh has asked to speak next and we're still speaking really on the DeCamp Amendments here, a Senator Cavanaugh.

CAVANAUGH: Well Mr. President I would rise to respon to your suggestion and to indicate that I would have agreement with your suggestion that not only the DeCamp Amendments but I would wonder if the Chair could through some manner consider all Amendments that are going to be offered on this Bill and have them, have them at least presented this morning and printed in the Journal and give us a day to consider all of these Amendments.

SPEAKER: If the Chair gets a motion to that effect, a

CAVANAUGH: A I would, I would move to that effect, if thats proper.

SPEAKER: All right, actually we have Senator Chambers motion to add the Emergency Clause coming in so we'll just include that in the packet of the Amendments we have which the Chair understands. We have 3 Amendments up here now, and so do you all understand the motion? Are there any objections to

CAVANAUGH: A Mr. President, if I might Amend that motion to to include that everyone who does have Amendments to this Bill, offer them at this time. I don't know if thats proper motion, but I would maybe request that everybody who has Amendments offer them at this time, and then,

SPEAKER: The Chair would accept that. Senator Carpenter.

CARPENTER: Knows what the Emergency Clause is, so I ask we adopt that now, as long as nobodys in disagreement with it.

SPEAKER: All right, theres isn't any objections then to adopting the Emergency Clause on the Bill at this time? Hearing none, so ordered. The Emergency Clause adopted.

CARPENTER: Then to Amend the other motion that we take it up on Tuesday of next week, because that will give the body a time to look at the Amendments if they so desire, and then we do one of the other things in that particular time.

SPEAKER: We now have a motion to bracket LB 268 until Tuesday of next week and that all the Amendments to this Bill be printed in the Journal. Chair recognizes Senator DeCamp on that motion.

DECAMP: I would hardly concur with this, and I would hope that we could also take the Amendments and give them to the Attorney General and get an opinion from him. I see Senator Carpenters concern.
