CLERK: Read. Legislative Resolution 20.

SPEAKER: The Resolution will be referred.

CLERK: Read. Legislative Resolution 21.

SPEAKER: We will also refer that Resolution. It will be laid over. Very good. Do we have any bills for introduction?

CLERK: An "A" bill, Mr. President. LB 111A. Read title.

SPEAKER: What else do we have on the desk?

CLERK: A motion for the introduction of the attached bills. Request #753. Introduced by the Ag Committee, Senators Schmit, Kennedy, Carsten (Cal Carsten), Kime, and Rasmussen. A bill relating to the Environmental Protection Act.

SPEAKER: The chair recognizes Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, I move the introduction of the bill. The reason for this bill is to bring the penalty section of the Nebraska statute for government Environmental Control in compliance with that of the federal government and we would like to hold a public hearing on this bill one week from today, so I have asked permission to introduce the bill in this manner.

SPEAKER: Is there further discussion of the motion? The question is shall the rules be suspended and the bill introduced. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Senator Schmit asking for a suspension of the Rules for the introduction of the bill. All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. The chair would remind the body that that does take 30 votes for the introduction of the bill. Have you all voted? Once again, have you all voted?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. Chairman.

PRESIDENT: Senator Schmit.

CLERK: Legislative Resolution 22.

PRESIDENT: Read the date again, please.

CLERK: May 22nd, '73 at 1 o'clock in the Hall of Fame in the State Capitol.
