SENATOR DUIS: I would prefer you wait until next week, you can see me in the mean time, I'll be glad to help you, there are no intentions of passing any legislation in this bill that is objective to people that are within reason, but I don't want to discuss it today, because we are on non controversial bills and had I have known that you were going to get up, I would have passed it by my original suggestion, so I ask it now.

PRESIDENT: That's okay, we did at least get the amendments adopted, that puts the bill in it's entirety. Alright, then we will move on to general file consideration of LB 86. 86 Senator Duis, do you want to pass over 86 Senator Duis?

SENATOR DUIS: I don't believe, well I guess Senator Snyder has got a man that wants to see me on that after about four weeks too, so let's pass it by too, it's perfectly alright, no hurry on these bills.

PRESIDENT: Pass 86, that brings it down to LB 25, Senator Carpenter, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR CARPENTER: These two bills that we, put them to a day certain.

PRESIDENT: Pardon me sir.

SENATOR CARPENTER: On the two bills, 68 and 86 are we in agreement that on some specific day we are going to dispose of these bills, because I know people who we never will get to them, these bills have been, went over time and time again, and they represent an agreement of most of the people involved, not all of them, the only point I had, what time are we going to consider this, and not lay it over.

PRESIDENT: The Clerk is mentioning to me that we don't have any bills set for the 21st, we have a skip in between like for instance the 20th and the 22nd there on the board for bracketing, if somebody wants to, do you want to, Senator Duis, you want to bracket what -

SENATOR DUIS: This will be fine with me, let's bracket 68 and 86 for the 21st and please be cognizant of this Senator Barnett and Senator Snyder, because I want you to be with me before that time, thank you.

PRESIDENT: That will include 68A also, okay, bracket 68, 68A, and 86 for March 21st. That brings us down to the general file consideration of LB 25.

CLERK: Title Read LB 25. There were no committee amendments Mr. President, there are amendments offered by Senator Cal Carstens.

PRESIDENT: Very good, Senator Carstens do you want to test the water?

SENATOR CARSTENS: Mr. President, and members of the body, would you want to read that part that is amended Vince?

CLERK: The whole thing or -

SENATOR CARSTENS: No just that part that is amended.

CLERK: Okay (read).

PRESIDENT: Senator Carstens.
