PRESIDENT: Well I can tell you that we sent out to have copies brought in -

SENATOR NORE: That's why we haven't got anything done up here we didn't get the list.

PRESIDENT: Right. Okay, Senator Proud.

SENATOR PROUD: I believe the list is on the desk, those were distributed weren't they Vince? I believe everybody has that list on their, list on their desk.

PRESIDENT: Thank you Senator Proud. While we are wrestling up a copy, the Chair would like to have one likewise, it might facilitate things. The motion before us of course is that we go ahead and take bills as they appear on general file, that's the motion before the body at this time, thank you. Senator Carpenter do you wish to be heard on the motion?

SENATOR CARPENTER: Well start with bill 336 and 336A, start at that point and start going and let's get rid of them one way or the other.

PRESIDENT: Now we have to vote on Barnett's motion, Senator Barnett's motion first.

SENATOR CARPENTER: But I want to amend his motion to start with LB 336.

PRESIDENT: Alright, is there any discussion of that amendment? Alright, are you in favor of the amendment offered by Senator Carpenter, to Senator Barnett's motion, all in favor of the motion say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered, the amendment is adopted, we are back to Senator Barnett's motion now which would take the bills as they appear on general file beginning with LB 336, is there any further discussion of the motion, all those in favor of the motion vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Before we finish voting I think the Chair should announce that I think I would require that 25 votes be required here in order to bind the body to this action. Voting on Senator Barnett's motion which is to take bills on general file just as they occur, beginning with LB 336. Have you all voted? Once again have you all voted. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 8 nays, remainder not, 14 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Alright we will begin the general file discussion of LB 336, Senator Duis bill. The Clerk will read the title.

CLERK: Title Read LB 336. There are no amendments, committee or otherwise.

PRESIDENT: Senator Duis before I turn this floor over to you, the Chair would like the prerogative of introducing from Senator Thome Johnson's district eleven members of the Elkhorn View Extension Club from Dodge County and they are from Hooper, Nebraska, and they are seated up here in the south balcony this morning, and they are watching the proceedings, Mrs. Kenneth Nelson is the president and Mrs. William Liston is the Vice-President, and we are delighted to have you folks here today to view the activities of the Nebraska Unicameral Legislature. Now then, Senator Duis proceed.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President and members of the legislature, contrary to what might have been said prior, this school has always been a state school. This school has been funded by
