Judges salaries.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the Amendment? Question is, shall the Amendment be adopted. All those in favor, please say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered. The Luedtke Amendment is adopted.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Now, Mr. President, are there any other Amendments? I don't, are there any other Amendments to the bill? All right, I would move then that LB 228 be advanced to E & R for initial. Mr. President, members of the Legislature I just might say this, this Bill merely brings the separate Juvenile Courts in line with all the other District County courts which in the other counties of the State handle Juvenile court matters, so that they are all on a unified State Court system. This could have been done in 10-32, but was not done, because we didn't know whether it, 10-32 would pass, now that it has passed, then it is proper and correct that the two courts, in Douglas and Lancaster county, the separate Juvenile Courts, join all the rest of the courts in the State, as a State system, and that the courts and staff be on the State plan.

PRESIDENT: Are you all through debating LB 228 as Amended? Question is, shall LB 228 as Amended be advanced from General file, to E & R initial. All those in favor, vote aye, all those opposed, vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, no nays, 22 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The Bill is advanced. This brings up the General File consideration of 228A. Senator Stahmer, would you turn off your little light for me. Thank-you sir.

CLERK: (READ BILL) There are Amendments Mr. President by Senator Luedtke, to delete the extra word, thousand, in page 2 line 6.

PRESIDENT: Senator Luedtke.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President, I would move the adoption of the Amendment. I think this is a perfect example, of why introducers of Bills, better read Bills and also why you better read all A Bill, because this kind of typographical error could get us into serious problems and probably the Fiscal, the Fiscal crunch. If you'll read what this really says, it adds a thousand on the end of what it really means, so that it instead of reading 84,393, it would read 84,393,000 So you just add three more zeros on that, and you see where it would take it. So this Amendment corrects it to what it should be 84,000.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the Amendment. Question is, shall the Amendment be adopted? All those in favor please say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered. The Amendment is adopted. Senator Luedtke back to you.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Now, Mr. President I would move that LB 228A be advanced to E & R initial.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the Bill? All through debating? Question is, shall LB 228 be advanced from General File to E & R initial. All those in favor, vote aye, all those in opposed vote no. Well, the Chair is not in position to be lobbying for votes, but it does take 25 to move a Bill off of General File. Thank-you. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, no nays, 24 not voting.

PRESIDENT: LB 228 A as Amended is advanced. That does take
