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with which I agree. But I think that in this particular instance, the Governor wants to rely upon the fact that we could use federal funds, a question, by the way, that he himself raised with regard to our correctional program when he, at one point, stated that there was kind of a hoax here because the federal funds might not be available. This is quite true. We do not know what the situation is with LEAA funds in the next couple of years. We have hopes that we will be able to get them, but we are not sure that we are going to be able to get them. And as Senator Barnett said, we are talking about the "narcs", the Narcotic, the Drug Investigators that, not only just the investigators, but the officers who will get the job done, who go out and thoroughly... go out to bring in these pushers that we are so interested in and that's the job we have to do. One other thing I want to mention why I'm in favor of overriding this veto, you can use these federal funds if they're available, but I believe that I am correct in this. Maybe, Senator Schmit, you might know this and I'll address the question to you. I believe that the federal funds under LEAA can only be used for one year. Then, you would have to go on your own anyway.

SENATOR SCHMIT: That is right, Senator Luedtke.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: That's correct? Now if that's so, then we are going to set up a very limited, shortterm situation. Granted as Senator, I think, Senator Whitney stated, we will be back here next year, that's true. But I think we ought
