corrupt any law enforcement person they come up with. So let's finance this thing, let's finance these undercover people, the one area in which we can really get down to the bottom of the thing, I believe, is to provide the undercover people, the people who work in those areas incognito who develop the cases, who help build the case for arrest and prosecution, which we so definitely need. I'm not going to come back before this body time after time, and plead my case, it is not my case, it is a case that is responsible to all of us. Each of us has that responsibility. Senator Kennedy talks about many areas of need and I can tell him and he knows it, that this is true that I have supported those areas. We need to support those areas where the need is greatest. We need to support the troopers in this area, we need to support all law enforcement and we need to commend and help those people who have been effective in the past and provide them the tools we need, they need to do the job. I hope that you will join me in voting to override the Governor's veto of LB 13.
