

PRESIDENT: Is there any further discussion of the second Snyder amendment. Question is shall the amendment be adopted. All those in favor say aye. Those opposed say no. It is so ordered. The Snyder second amendment then is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have was an amendment offered by Senator Carpenter which was printed in full in the Legislative Journal on page 606. Prior to adoption of the amendment I believe it was withdrawn and now the amendment is back on the bill again.

PRESIDENT: Now, Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President. The original amendment that was in the Legislative Journal is to be withdrawn by Senator Carpenter and the new amendment, which is the short one, would be on Journal page 606, I believe, and this short amendment is one that he wishes on there. Now Senator Carpenter called this morning that he wouldn't be here but to please go ahead with the bill and I would take the amendment for him because the amendment is perfectly agreeable with everyone.

PRESIDENT: Well, go ahead, Senator Duis, you can handle it.

CLERK: It's the one on 606 that you do want to adopt, Senator Duis?

SENATOR DUIS: It's one that says on page 5, line 16 after "therein" strike "and not" and insert "yes."

PRESIDENT: It's your pleasure, Senator Duis. Whatever you choose.

SENATOR DUIS: Well, the amendment actually doesn't do a whole lot to the bill except that Senator Carpenter did wish to have another member on the Real Estate Board of Commissioners and he wished to have a member at large which we provided for and this was perfectly acceptable to the Real Estate Commission and so this was the reason for the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carstens, did you wish to be heard on--

SENATOR DUIS: There is also, an amendment here also in this particular one which would, reinsert back into the bill the privilege of the attorneys of, which they had in the original bill and that's in this amendment and this is what Senator Waldron was interested in and so this was done all in the Carpenter amendment.

PRESIDENT: Now, Senator Carstens, did you wish to be heard on this amendment? Senator Carstens? All right. Question is then shall the Carpenter amendment as explained by Senator Duis be adopted. All those in favor say aye. Those opposed say no. It is so ordered then, the Carpenter amendment is adopted. Back to you Senator Duis. Wait a minute, is there another amendment on the desk?

CLERK: None.

PRESIDENT: Very good. Back to you, Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Well, Mr. President and Members of the Legislature. I have gone through the bill before. Its been a long time ago. We've been coming up to this bill on general file for about two weeks but we never seem to be able to get to general file at this part of it but the bill was explained before and these amendments were on there and I would let it go at that and I don't know whether Senator Carstens has anything he wishes to input on the bill or not. Did you, Senator Carstens?
