

procedure is that we'll say that schools have the land and they may sell it if they wish. Now all I'm asking in my amendment and the DeCamp amendment is far superior to mine, is that the purchaser should also have a right to go to the schools and request that they be allowed to purchase. Just trying to get a dialogue, a two way street that does make a business sense instead of just a one way sale and no recourse back the other way, and this amendment procedure would allow an orderly disposal of the school lands.
