PRESIDENT: The Chair understands there are two more amendments other than Senator Kelly's.

CLERK: No the Kelly amendment is the only one I know have.

PRESIDENT: I'm sorry. If the DeCamp amendment had been adopted Senator Lewis that would have struck the Kelly amendment. We still have the Kelly amendment, the DeCamp amendment was unsuccessful.

SENATOR PROUD: Well I'm going to withhold my motion, but let's get cracking.

PRESIDENT: Alright, very fine. Back to Senator Kelly, then, is there any further discussion of Senator Kelly's motion? Senator Kelly you may close.

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. President, I'd request unanimous consent to withdraw my amendment.

PRESIDENT: Alright, are there objections to withdrawal of the amendment, Senator Lewis do you object?

SENATOR LEWIS: Move the bill.

PRESIDENT: Alright, fine, the Kelly amendment is withdrawn, back to you Senator Lewis on the bill.

SENATOR LEWIS: I move that we advance 145 to E&R initial.

PRESIDENT: Now is there any further discussion of LB 145 as amended? The question is shall LB 145 as amended be advanced from general file to E&R initial, all those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Alright, I'll wait for you Senator Richendifer. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 2 nays, 19 not voting.

PRESIDENT: LB 145 is advanced. Is there any other business to come before the body?

CLERK: None.

PRESIDENT: We have a motion to adjourn until 9:00 tomorrow morning, all those in favor of the motion please signify by saying aye, those opposed say no, so ordered, we're adjourned until 9:00 tomorrow morning.
