SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 162.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the amendments to LB 162. All those in favor of the motion, say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered. The amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move LB 162 as amended be advanced.
