Senator Snyder.

SENATOR SNYDER: They both deal with the same section.

PRESIDENT: That's correct.

SENATOR SNYDER: Could we have that restated.

PRESIDENT: Pardon me.

SENATOR SNYDER: Could we have the Warner...was there a change to what is printed in the Journal.

CLERK: Well, it is on Page 736...

SENATOR SNYDER: Well, I've got that.

CLERK: That's the one he's working on.

PRESIDENT: That's the way it was submitted, it's the chair's understanding. And the one on 83...

SENATOR SNYDER: Well, actually, my question was to the... to the one right below it, the Maresh proposal. Go ahead and take this and I will come back to it.

PRESIDENT: Well, I think Senator Duis is next to be heard here. Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, may I respectfully request here that the changes in the Rules as brought out from the Rules Committee, if they would be done by amendment to these changes, we'd appreciate it very much because we did have a hearing on these and if Senator Warner wishes to have the Rule change as it appears on Page 736, if he'd make a motion then to substitute that for ours and then a vote could be held on that or discussion held on it and then amended, because we certainly want to have these Rules in the position that the entire Legislature is agreement or, at least, 30 members of them are. So, I would suggest that we make amendments here on the floor to the Rules changes as brought forth from the Rules Committee so we can dispose of them today. The reason I say this is because we are going to have another Executive session of the Rules Committee very shortly to consider the balance of the Rules so we can bring them before you because we would like to get this Rule Book reprinted. It's a real mess now. We adopted all these Rule changes without any dissent at the beginning of the session as a great big blanket and we found place after place after place that have had to have Rule changes and changes of ideas. So, if we might dispose of this this morning, we would appreciate it very much so that we can continue and get to a new Rule Book so that everyone is able to follow the Rules at the present time. So, we would suggest that amendments be made to the changes. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Well, Senator Duis, it is the chair's understanding now that Senator Warner has moved that the language as found on Page 736 be substituted for that found on 835.

SENATOR DUIS: That I'd appreciate very much and I thank you.

SENATOR SNYDER: I didn't understand him to make a motion. I'm sorry.

PRESIDENT: I think that's correct. Senator Warner, back to you now.

SENATOR WARNER: Again, as I hear the discussion, I think many of the members feel that it is questionable whether all the bills on the Board should be returned to Committee and I don't disagree with that particularly, but it does seem to
