

through the old continuing resolution under the old bill, whether it's a brand new bill that's earmarked Voc Rehab or whether it comes into Special Educational Revenue Sharing.

SENATOR BARNETT: --Okay. Thank you.

HEW: You're welcome.

SPEAKER: Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Question for Mr. Smith.

MR. SMITH: Yes.

SENATOR GOODRICH: You were referring to the decisions that we were going to have to be making on a state level as opposed to a federal level and I was wondering what you could tell us about the guidelines for those decisions and how we can use that money without jeopardizing future revenue sharing. Where do we get those guidelines?

MR. SMITH: This is one of the major responsibilities that we as a Regional Council have is as these bills are introduced and as the guidelines are developed, to be in constant contact with you to discuss with you, make available to you, the information as quickly as developed and try to get back from you how those regulations are going to affect, that this is, 3 of the Special Revenue Sharing
