cussed the other day when the bill came up. I think the policy should be adopted by this body as to whether or not the proxies that are automatically available to depositors in the building and loan be given to them rather than be retained by the building and loan and to sign to give them the right of the proxy without any further action on their part. That's what the amendment does. I think the Legislature ought to adopt the policy now whether you want to continue the present policy or change.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the Carpenter amendment? Senator Savage, do you wish to be heard on the amendment?

SENATOR SAVAGE: This amendment is objectionable because it would severely cripple the association in their voting at the annual meetings and, furthermore, since federal associations would not be required to comply with this provision, it would place the state chartered associations at a serious disadvantage in the country to compete with the federal associations. So, therefore, I would like a motion to reject this amendment.

SPEAKER PROUD: Any further discussion on the Carpenter amendment? Now, are you ready for the question? All those in favor of the Carpenter amendment say aye. Those opposed no. Do you agree, Senator Carpenter, that the amendment is lost. The chair so declares, unless there is serious objection. Now, Senator Savage.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Motion to advance to E & R Initial.

SPEAKER: All right. Is there any further discussion? Has this bill been explained, Senator Savage?

SENATOR SAVAGE: Yes. It was read the other day and explained. The amendments, the Committee amendments were adopted. My amendment was adopted. It was laid over to hear Senator Carpenter's amendment. There was no objections in the Committee hearing and I move it to E & R Initial.

SPEAKER: Any further discussion? The question is shall the bill be advanced? All those in favor vote aye. Those opposed vote no. Requires 25 votes. We are going to have to have a Call of the House.

SENATOR SAVAGE: A Call of the House.

SPEAKER: The clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, 2 not...

SPEAKER: The bill is advanced. LB 357.

CLERK: Read title. LB 357. This bill was first considered on May 27. Committee amendments have been adopted. The bill was laid over. There is now an amendment on it by Senator Anderson--read.

SPEAKER: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, Senator Anderson isn't here. I would move the adoption of this amendment. What it does, the bill as it was originally drafted designated the Department of Motor Vehicles to issue, it was my understanding from our staff that that was adequate to Rules and Regulations, that the Department could then designate County Treasurers to issue as normally would their other registrations or licenses, and in this case, it would specifically direct the County Treasurer, which is the way it would be done normally, to do it but by forms furnished by the Department
