SENATOR SYAS: Yes, but he's, he's getting the camper thing at a, at a smaller rate isn't he?

SENATOR MARESH: No, no it's the same rate. This is when people go to hauling large loads with, with--for farm products with a commercial license then he has to pay a larger fee, maybe up to \$32 if he hauls a large armload with this--

SENATOR SYAS: Skip the commercial a minute, the commercial license. How about the farm license?

SENATOR MARESH: Well, that's \$18 right.

SENATOR SYAS: \$18, and what is it for a camper?

SENATOR MARESH: --up to 1 ton, then 1 ton and more it's \$22, for--

SENATOR SYAS: All right. What is it for a camper?

SENATOR MARESH: Well, it depends on the size of the camper. If he--

SENATOR SYAS: All right, we'll just say comparatively, weight.

SENATOR MARESH: A small camper would be \$18 for either commercial license or farm truck license.

SENATOR SYAS: All right. Go up one now.

SENATOR MARESH: Well, it'd be \$22 for 1 ton and a commercial would be--up to 3 tons would be \$18 and 4 tons and higher would \$25.

SENATOR SYAS: How about you're skipping the farm license, so on, I want to know compared to the farm license.

SENATOR MARESH: Commercial compared to farm license?

SENATOR SYAS: Yeah. No, no, commercial, I mean the farm license compared to the camper license.

SENATOR MARESH: It depends on the size of the load.

SENATOR SYAS: Well, let's, let's, let's go up a couple of steps, let's go load by load. I want to see what the difference is
