adding a Motorcycle Dealer. The present Motor Vehicle Licensing Board consists of Director of Motor Vehicles and eight members appointed by the Governor, the representation is one factory representative, one member of the general public, three new car dealers, two used car dealers, one trailer dealer, or a combination of trailer and motor vehicle dealer. This bill would add one motorcycle dealer to this making the number on the board nine in place of eight. What this board does is basically charged with administering Nebraska Vehicle Industry Licensing Act which clearly deals with Motorcycle Dealers in such vital areas as licensing through business, franchise, advertising, suspension of license, license display, motorcycles at sport shows. The motorcycle industry is grown to the point where they think they should have representation on this board, in fact we have roughly 36,000 motorcycles registered in Nebraska today and we also have fifty motorcycle dealers. I would move for the advancement of LB 443 to E&R initial.
