CLERK: All right. Mr. President, we have a motion to unbracket LB 43 on E & R Final and then to return it to Select File for specific amendment. It would be unanimous consent to unbracket it by Senator Stull.

PRESIDENT: Senator Stull.

SENATOR STULL: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this would be a... I want to return it to Select File to adopt an amendment to the Committee amendment and it says, "other than the district in which he resides". This would reduce the fiscal impact on this bill by \$248,000. I move that it should be returned for the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Stull is asking unanimous consent to unbracket LB 43 on E & R Final, return it to Select File for that specific amendment. Now, that's the motion under discussion. Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: What's the motion do?

PRESIDENT: Senator Stull, do you want to repeat the motion again.

CLERK: The first one is to just unbracket the bill and then to return it to Select File for specific amendment. On Page 2, line 1 strike "six" and strike line 2 and insert "four hundred six thousand eight hundred seventy-five".

SENATOR CARPENTER: I would object unless the Senator... as I understand this is a bill which appropriates originally seven hundred thousand dollars for tuition and apparently it is now down to four hundred thousand dollars, and this is one of these things that... I think we ought to hold these things up until the Budget bill gets here. We can get some idea of where we are going. I don't want to be disagreeable. I have no objection to bringing it back if the Senator would leave it on Select File after it is amended, if it is amended.

PRESIDENT: Well, Senator Stull, do you care to respond? Stand by, Senator Mahoney.

SENATOR STULL: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, if we could adopt this amendment and then, also, the amendment to the 43A, I would be willing, then, to hold them on Final Reading, when they get over there until the Appropriations Bill comes out.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: May I answer the Senator. It is agreeable to me if you bracket the bills until Thursday of this week. Let's bring it over to Select File and amend it and let's hold this and the other bill until Thursday, that's Thursday of this week.

SENATOR STULL: On Select File?

SENATOR CARPENTER: On Select File.

SENATOR STULL: OK. Agreeable.

PRESIDENT: Senator Stull, I don't think the chair heard your response to that motion. All right. Senator Mahoney.

SENATOR MAHONEY: I would like to ask Senator Stull a question.

PRESIDENT: Senator Stull, will you yield to a question?

SENATOR STULL: Sure.

SENATOR MAHONEY: It is all right about bringing it back to
