SENATOR KELLY: Mr. President, members of the body, let's dump the Marsh amendment and get on. We all know where we are on this thing. Everybody has given and everybody has given pretty hard and Senator Marsh can give \$9 and let's get on the way.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the motion? Question. Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: I withdraw my motion. I ask unanimous consent to withdraw my motion.

PRESIDENT: Are there objections to withdrawal of the motion? Hearing none, so ordered. The motion is withdrawn. Back to Senator Cavanaugh's motion which the chair understands is embodying the figure of \$80. Is there any further discussion of Senator Cavanaugh's motion to LB 193? Question is shall the amendment be adopted? All those in favor say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered, the amendment is adopted. Are there other amendments to 193?

CLERK: None on the desk.

PRESIDENT: Very good. Senator Syas.

SENATOR SYAS: I appreciate the work done and work done by other Senators and the compromise arrived at. I move that 193 be advanced.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion now of the bill? The question is, shall LB 193 as amended be advanced from General File to E & R Initial? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Voting on the advancement from General File to E & R Initial of 193. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, no nays, 20 not voting, President.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. What does that do now to 342? Senator Clark.

SENATOR CLARK: Members of the body, I'd move that 342 be killed. I think that's the easiest way to take care of it.

PRESIDENT: All right, any further discussion? Question is, shall LB 342 be indefinitely postponed? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. The motion is to indefinitely postpone LB 342, Senator Clark's bill. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, no nays on the motion to kill.

PRESIDENT: LB 342 is indefinitely postponed. That moves us on to the General File consideration of LB 180.

CLERK: Reads title. The bill, Mr. President, was considered on March 27 and the bill was read at that time and laid over. The Standing Committee Amendments were adopted, I believe, yes, Standing Committee Amendments were adopted. Another amendment by Senator Simpson to the Standing Committee Amendments was adopted. There are pending amendments offered by Senator Skarda.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Skarda.

SENATOR SKARDA: It doesn't make any difference to me but I believe Senator Lewis' name is on the amendment, isn't it? When I gave it to you, I gave it to you that day for Senator Lewis. I know what the amendment does but I'd rather have Senator Lewis do it.

CLERK: It's got Senator Skarda--well, Senator Lewis, I think
