SENATOR CARPENTER: Certainly.

SENATOR STROMER: Senator Carpenter, has the Board of Trustees which you just referred to in your last bit of information ever made any official application or any... officially in any way requested the facilities in Beatrice?

SENATOR CARPENTER: All I knew is what Senator Carstens said. He said they asked him to include them in this bill, that the Normal would take this school over. I only have his word for it. He can answer himself. If that is not so, I hope Senator Carstens says what he meant.

SPEAKER: Senator Kremer, did you want to speak to the amendment? Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: Well, yes, both to the amendment and to the bill, then, as the amendment relates to the bill. I'd like to start by asking Senator Carpenter some questions, please.

SPEAKER: Senator Carstens, will you yield?

SENATOR KREMER: No, Carpenter, sir.

SPEAKER: Oh, Senator Carpenter, excuse me.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Yes.

SENATOR KREMER: Senator Carpenter, you bring in the term "related subjects" when you referred to agriculture and to medicine, and so on. Just what do you mean by "related subjects"?

SENATOR CARPENTER: This is drawn for me at my request by the University in the field, basely, of those subjects related to which they have the custody of now which are all under their area now as they were enumerated in the bill, and I would presume it meant in the field of which they now have the prime responsibility. These things would have to be related to those things enumerated in this amendment.

SENATOR KREMER: All right, and, then, to continue. The University there now, Senator Carpenter, may I continue questions. The University there now does still have the experiment station, the Agriculture Experiment Station.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Yes.

SENATOR KREMER: Now, are those facilities at Scottsbluff, or did I understand you to say they are at Mitchell. Which are they? I thought they were at Scottsbluff.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Say that again.

SENATOR KREMER: Experiment station. The facilities are at Scottsbluff or at Mitchell.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Mitchell.

SENATOR KREMER: They are not at Scottsbluff.

SENATOR CARPENTER: No, it is about eight miles from Scottsbluff.

SENATOR KREMER: In what condition are the facilities there, the buildings and so on. I am leading up to a point I want to make in favor to your bill.

SENATOR CARPENTER: You mean in Mitchell.

SENATOR KREMER: Yes.
