SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move LB 414.

CLERK: There are some further amendments to 414 by Senator Stromer. These amendments were printed in the Journal in full on Page 1133.

PRESIDENT: Senator Stromer, we are ready for your amendments to LB 414 on Select File.

SENATOR STROMER: These particular amendments, we found a part of this was redundant and was not necessary. So, if you turn to the original bill, LB 414, actually in essence, all we retained is Section 4 which then becomes Section 1. Also, the other change, I don't know if it's...if we can quite take care of printing into law that a national organization could be used as far as a standard of setting up the courts, so, we, instead, referred to the minimum qualifications of that court which, then, would have to be approved by the Motor Vehicles Department. Those are the only changes for those amendment which I did not have when we discussed it on General File the other day.
