SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move that LB 307 as amended be advanced to E&R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: There is now a motion to advance the bill as amended. All those in favor of that motion please say aye. Those opposed say no. It is so ordered, the bill is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E&R amendments to LB 475.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the amendments to 475. All those in favor of that motion, please say aye. Those opposed say no. Amendments are adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move that LB 475 as amended be advanced to E&R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: There is a motion now to advance the bill as amended. All those in favor of the movement of the bill please say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered, the bill as amended is advanced. We have 488 I think also, on select file.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E&R amendments to LB 488.

PRESIDENT: Now, wait a minute. Just add the E clause. Do we have 488--chair recognizes Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman, I now move that the Emergency Clause be added to 488.

PRESIDENT: Is there any further discussion? Question is shall the Emergency Clause be added to LB 488 on select file? All those in favor will vote aye. All those opposed will vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, Mr. President, on motion to adopt.

PRESIDENT: E clause is adopted. Motion carries. We can now move 488 on.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move LB 488 as amended be advanced to E&R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion now to advance--readvance LB 488 as amended. All those in favor of readvancing the bill please say aye. Those opposed say no. It is so ordered, the bill as amended is readvanced. Alright. Thank you, Senator Cavanaugh.

CLERK: Committee reports read. Select file consideration asked.

PRESIDENT: 5--546 is on select file? And you say there is--

CLERK: Maresh amendments.
