They have water that does have one part per million and if that's true, it would meet the requirements of this bill and so everyone of their cows drinks milk with one part per million and so in answer to, in answer to the Senator that wondered what would happen to a cow that drank fluoridated milk, they can ask Senator Stull--water--thank you, and I like also to mention that Senator Stull's son when he entered the Army, was checked by the dentist and the dentist was amazed to find a perfect set of teeth and he called other dentists in to take a look and--because they very seldom see a perfect set of teeth and that was also with his second son. Of course you can say that might be true in other districts but it is, was of interest to me. Senator Proud mentioned that the fluoridation is, makes for healthy teeth but he wondered about the rest of the body might die sooner, but I'd like to tell Senator Proud that the Nebraska Medical Association, as well as the National Medical Association, and also the Board of Governors, Mayo Clinic have endorsed this 100% and so it does make for a healthier body, not--we've talked about teeth almost entirely this morning, but it does make for a healthier body even in older people and that certainly shouldn't be overlooked and so I urge you not to vote for the kill motion.
