substantially the bill. So the first amendment which became the bill in effect was the substitute the liberal portions of the Governor's bill for the bill. Then it became necessary to amend that by taking the liberal portions of Senator Whitney's bill and attaching them to what the Governor offered. The second amendment will merely make the written portion of the bill which is above the column of figures coincide properly with the figures. In other words, the words had to be changed so that they stated what the numbers indicated. And I would ask for the adoption of these amendments.

PRESIDENT: Senator Chambers, does the chair understand that you want to take the two separately? So we're speaking about the first set of amendments.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: In a way...

CLERK: There's only one committee amendment, right?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Right. But there was an additional amendment, I think it came from one of the offices downstairs to make the written portion of the bill conform to the figures, to the schedule of figures.

PRESIDENT: Is it part of the committee amendment?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: No, it came after the committee amendment.

PRESIDENT: So we're actually at this time adopting the committee amendment then to LB 469.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: We'll take that first then.

PRESIDENT: All right, are there any, is there any further discussion now of the committee amendments to 469 as explained by Senator Chambers?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Nobody's listening so I vote aye.

PRESIDENT: Just a minute. Any further discussion? Question is, shall the committee amendments to 469 be adopted? All those adopted please say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered, the amendments are adopted. There's more than you thought.

CLERK: All right, now, Mr. President, there are some additional amendments offered by Senator Chambers.

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Now again there is some textural material which had to be altered so that what it stated in words would fit what was given in the schedule of figures which went through some changes so all this does is make the words conform to the numbers and I would move the adoption of this amendment.

PRESIDENT: Now, does anybody need that amendment read? Question is, shall the Chambers amendment to LB 469 be adopted? All those in favor please say aye. Those opposed say no. So ordered, the amendment is adopted. All right now then, back to Senator Whitney.
