PRESIDENT: Thank you Senator Duis, now Senator Fellman did you wish to be heard on sub section 3, here, which relates of course to the accredited newspaper section, who shall have access to an area assigned by the Speaker. That's really the one that we should debate here and get it sort of dispatched and then we will move on to the next one.

SENATOR FELLMAN: Mr. President and members of the legislature, I'd like to move the call for the question, I think this has been debated now long enough, everybody has given their speech appealing to the press and to a good story in tomorrow mornings paper, I'd like to see a vote on this issue and I call for the question.

PRESIDENT: Alright, the question has been called for, does the Chair see five hands, alright, the question is shall the debate now close and this is on rule change sub section 3, all those in favor of closing the debate on that section please vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Your voting to close debate on sub section 3, of the rule change, as found on page 1177. Thank you, the Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes to close debate.

PRESIDENT: Alright, the debate will now close, then we are back to Senator Duis then, to close the debate on rule change sub section 3.

SENATOR DUIS: Thank you very much. I think everyone who has made, wanted to make a pitch to the press has been able to do it, so let's have the vote on this now, and I suggest that we vote, thank you.

PRESIDENT: Alright, now listen carefully, because we are voting only on sub section 3, on page 1177, under rule, under section B there, the question is shall that rule change be adopted, all those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Okay, have you all voted? Once again have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 2 ayes, 25 nays.

PRESIDENT: Alright, sub section rule 3, as proposed is defeated, then let's move to sub section 4.

SENATOR DUIS: Yes if we might move to sub section 4, and if Senator Luedtke, you had a pationate plea, have you got your amendment up there? The appationate amendment is up there on the pationate plea, thank you very much.

CLERK: Mr. President I have a motion to amend sub section 4, to strike or one and insert in lieu thereof and any, signed Senator Luedtke.

PRESIDENT: The Governor and any liaison person? Is there a need for discussion now of that amendment to the rule change? Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Question to remove the previous question.

PRESIDENT: Okay, we got to vote on the amendment it seems like, well that does become the amendment then, we'll have to vote on, oh, - The question is shall the amendment be adopted, all those
