

SENATOR CARPENTER: That's the part, that's the main reason for the amendment.

SENATOR SYAS: This will build us an olympic size pool, then?

SENATOR CARPENTER: That's the understanding that I have had from people in response to what you said, it'll be done if you allow them to use this money.

SENATOR SYAS: Okay, I, I'm in favor of the amendment.

SPEAKER: Are you ready for the question? Question is, shall the amendment be adopted? All those in favor say aye. Those opposed no. The amendment is adopted. Now are there further amendments, Mr. Clerk?

SENATOR CARPENTER: Is the emergency clause on the bill?

CLERK: --amendment by Senator Carpenter to add the emergency clause.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move for the adoption of the amendment.

SPEAKER: Is there any discussion on Senator Carpenter's amendment to add the emergency clause? If not are you ready for the question? All those in favor of adopting the emergency clause say aye. Those opposed no. It is adopted. Are there further amendments, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: None, Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Now, Senator Carpenter, what will you do with the bill?

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move the bill be advanced to E&R for initial. I have already expa--explained the bill.

SPEAKER: Is there further discussion? Are you ready for the question? Question is, shall the bill as amended be advanced? All those in favor vote aye. Those opposed vote no. This requires 25 votes. If you are going to vote, please do so because this just holds things up. Somebody will ask for a call of the house. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes on motion to advance.

SPEAKER: The bill as amended is advanced. LB 474.

CLERK: Legislative Bill 474. Introduced by Senator DeCamp. (read). There are committee amendments by Senator Luedtke's Judiciary Committee.

SPEAKER: Senator Luedtke.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President, I further move the adoption of the committee amendments. The committee amendment was brought in by one of the witnesses for the bill, Mr. Bill Brandt, representing Nebraska Bankers Association. This bill deals with replevin actions and so the bankers obviously are interested in what kind of replevin action and particularly with regard to recent United States Supreme Court opinions as to what has to be done in order to effectually have any such replevin and in order to take--
