SENATOR HASEBROOCK: Then the attempt here is to bring all of the townships in uniformity with other political subdivisions--

SENATOR ANDERSON: and, and--

SENATOR HASEBROOCK: --as far as the Budget Act is concerned.

SENATOR ANDERSON: Yes.

SENATOR HASEBROOCK: Uniform Budget Act.

SENATOR ANDERSON: Yes, bring them into full conformity with the Budget Act, bring them into full conformity with recent election law changes that have affected election laws generally in the State of Nebraska.

SENATOR HASEBROOCK: Thank you.

SPEAKER: Is there further discussion of these amendments? Are you ready for the question? All those in favor of the amendment say aye. Those opposed no. The amendment is adopted. Are there further amendments, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: None, Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Now, Senator Anderson, what will you do with the bill?

SENATOR ANDERSON: Now Mr. President, I have explained the bill itself at the beginning of my explanation so I simply move that LB 75 as amended be advanced to E&R initial.

SPEAKER: Are you ready for the question? The question is, shall the bill be advanced as amended? All those in favor vote aye. Those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, no nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER: The bill is advanced.
