SENATOR KEYES: Yes, that's amendments to Standing Committee amendments.

CLERK: OK. Now, then, you need to act on the Standing Committee amendments.

SENATOR KEYES: Now, Mr. President, I move that we accept the Standing Committee amendment as amended by my amendment.

SPEAKER: These are the Standing Committee amendments?

SENATOR KEYES: Yes.

SPEAKER: Any discussion of these amendments? Any further discussion? All those in favor of them say aye. Those opposed no. The amendments are adopted. Is there any further amendments, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: None.

SPEAKER: OK. Senator. What will you do with the bill?

SENATOR KEYES: I move, Mr. President, I move for the advancement of the bill. Now, this bill simply puts into practice, into statute, the practice of the Governor of the state of Nebraska today. We have had a great turnover in state employees and it is my feeling and the feeling of many people that we ought to be able to say to an employee when he starts to working for the state, this is going to be the policy that the state will follow according to statutes, as long as you work for the state. So, in order to stop some of the turnover and we have a great deal of concern about the turnover and the number of employees and the amount of money that we use here as a training house for the rest of the state, so I would suggest that we go ahead and put this into practice and it is probably one of the best, one of the better things we have done for state government this year. I move for the advancement of the bill.

SPEAKER: Is there any further discussion? Are you ready for the question? All those in favor of advancing the bill as amended bote aye. Those opposed vote no. This requires 25 votes. The clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays.

SPEAKER: LB..the bill is advanced. LB 321. The clerk will read.

CLERK: Read title. OB 321. There are no Committee amendments or other amendments.

SPEAKER: Senator Lewis.

SENATOR LEWIS: Mr. Speaker, this bill does two things. Number one, it does provide that compensation shall come out of existing cash fund from teacher certification and it, also, allows the Professional Practice Committee to make recommendations on reinstatements as well as revoking certificates. I move the bill be advanced.

SPEAKER: Any further discussion? If not, are you ready for the question? The question is shall the bill be advanced. All those in favor vote aye. Those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? The clerk will record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 1 nay, 20 not voting.

SPEAKER: The bill is advanced. LB 321A.

CLERK: Read title. LB 321A.
