**SPEAKER:** In the Department of Economic Development.

**SENATOR BARNETT:** No he hasn't. I don't believe he has. Bill Peters, the Tax Commissioner has.

**SENATOR MURPHY:** I would like to have your Industrial Development--Economic Development, whatever you choose to call it, take a look at it because I know for a fact that Nebraska has recently lost a rather considerable industrial prospect to the State of South Dakota where this very procedure took place and I would like to have his input to it. I'm not objecting to the bill per se but I'd like to have his approval on it before we pass it.

**SENATOR BARNETT:** Could I answer that question this way, and if you object to it, I would do what I agreed to do, to hold it over, but I think if you'll pay attention to the first or second line of the committee amendment it refers with respect to just any hospital and no other industry or business or anything, just hospital. Is that okay.

**SPEAKER:** Murphy, did you have further question or are you objecting to consideration of the bill at this time? Senator Barnett.

**SENATOR BARNETT:** The--if I can explain the first amendment, we put the word "leased" in between such and property so that it will designate the--eliminates the confusion over the matter of all hospital property being taxed rather than just the leased areas as is talked about in this bill. I would move for the adoption of the amendments.

**SPEAKER:** Is there further dis--are you referring to just one amendment?

**SENATOR BARNETT:** Right.
