that we have now bracketed as per the instructions this morning from Senator Carpenter, that we have bracketed things on Final Reading and therefore that deters Final Reading and passes that by. The next item would be, are there resolutions on the desk?

CLERK: None.

PRESIDENT: Do we have any bills for introduction?

CLERK: None.

PRESIDENT: All right, then we would move to the consideration of bills on Select File. We had 496 unbracketed this morning by unanimous consent and we also have 547, I believe, and I think we should clean up Select File as the agenda calls for it. Now Senator Cavanaugh.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Is 547 the only bill set? Does it have amendments on it?

CLERK: Which one are you taking up?

PRESIDENT: 547, then we'll take 496.

CLERK: The E & R amendments to 547 have been adopted. There's an amendment pending by Senator Carpenter to the bill as laid over. The amendment appears on page 1258 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator Carpenter, we have your motion to 547.

SENATOR CARPENTER: Will you read the amendment? I think it's necessary in order to correct the language in the bill.

CLERK: Reads amendment.

SENATOR CARPENTER: This is language necessary in order to correct the bill so that it would be legally and if passed operative. I move for the adoption of the amendment. This is all it does.

PRESIDENT: Is there any further discussion of the Carpenter motion to 547 on Select File? All those in favor will vote aye, all those opposed vote no. In order for the amendment to be adopted on Select File it takes 25 votes. Thank you. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes.

PRESIDENT: Motion is adopted. Amendment is adopted. Now Senator Cavanaugh, back to you on 547. Are there any other amendments now to 547? Stand by. Mr. Clerk, are there any other amendments to 547?

CLERK: None.

PRESIDENT: Senator Cavanaugh, no more amendments.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move that LB 547 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion now to advance the bill as amended. All those in favor of advancing the bill, please say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered, 547 as amended is advanced.

PRESIDENT: Are there amendments to 496?
