CLERK: No, Mr. President, the amendments to 496 have been adopted. There is nothing pending on the bill.

PRESIDENT: All right.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, I move LB 496 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion now to advance LB 496. Are there need for discussion? All those in favor of advancing the bill, please say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered, 496 is advanced. Do we have any other motions now on the desk?

CLERK: Yes. I move to return LB 469 to Select File to add the emergency clause. Signed, Senator Whitney.

PRESIDENT: All right, chair recognizes Senator Whitney for his amendment to 469.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Mr. President, it was felt that if this bill is to be passed it should be passed with the emergency clause and so I so move.

PRESIDENT: Question is, shall 469 be returned to Select File for the addition of the "E" clause? All those in favor of returning the bill for that amendment, please vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Thank you. Clerk will record. We have enough, Senator, thank you.

CLERK: 26 ayes, to return, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Okay, 469 is on Select File. Senator Whitney.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Now I move that the emergency clause be attached to LB 469.

PRESIDENT: Motion now is to attach the "E" clause to 469. All those in favor of attaching the "E" clause to the bill on Select File please vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Thank you. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes on motion to adopt.

PRESIDENT: The emergency clause is adopted to 469. Senator Whitney.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Now I move that LB 469 be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Motion now is to advance LB 469 as amended. All those in favor of the motion please say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered, the bill as amended is advanced. Any other motions on the desk?

CLERK: I have an Attorney General's opinion, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Read the opinion.

CLERK: Reads.

PRESIDENT: Any other motions on the desk?

CLERK: None, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Under the instructions given this morning, it is the chair's understanding that the first order of business on General File this afternoon will be the debate of LB 259. I suppose that--Senator Marvel.
