SENATOR MARVEL: I make a motion that 259 without any amendments be advanced to E & R Initial.

PRESIDENT: Is there any further discussion now of the bill? We'd better read the title up here. Stand by.

CLERK: Reads title. There are committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: All right, we have committee amendments which you will have to dispose of.

SENATOR MARVEL: What?

PRESIDENT: There are committee amendments to the bill. You'll have to do something with them.

SENATOR MARVEL: Oh, well, I move that the committee amendments be rejected.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Is there any further discussion of that motion, of the action? Question is, shall the committee amendments be rejected? All those in favor say aye, those opposed say no. The ayes have it. So ordered, the amendments are rejected.

SENATOR MARVEL: I renew my motion to advance the bill without amendment.

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator Schmidt, for what purpose did you wish to be recognized? Okay, is there any further discussion of the motion? Senator Proud.

SENATOR PROUD: Well, I realize this is going to be advanced. I don't know how far but let's please understand that we're advancing now against my vote of course the Governor's bill without any discussion whatsoever, and without any of you considering this item by item or the bill as a whole and if that's the way you want to do business, just go right ahead.

PRESIDENT: Now is there any further discussion of the bill? Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: I have a question for Senator Marvel for clarification.

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator Marvel, will you yield to a question?

SENATOR MARVEL: Yes, sir.

SENATOR WARNER: For my own information, Senator Marvel, as you know, as I understand it 259 as introduced provided an appropriation for 7 areas for community colleges. In order for that to be operable I would assume that 533 we would need some amendments drafted which will fit counties into seven areas so that that can, so that they can function under the act, appropriations act? The reason I ask is I'm assuming if this bill is advanced then we should have the staff immediately draw amendments to 533 which will make it possible for it to be in line with the Governor's appropriation bill so that those schools that are left can function.

SENATOR MARVEL: Well, in direct answer to your question, the amendments or the appropriation in 259 is to seven areas, 533 is to five areas. Is that your question?

SENATOR WARNER: Yes, so would it not be necessary that I have amendments drafted to 533 that will fit 259?

SENATOR MARVEL: Well, that's assuming that 533 would, as I
